CPR

Leaders will become CPR certified by an American Red Cross trainer. Troops are required to have a First Aid and CPR trained adult at meetings, or trips, and while camping.

Training content includes: Emergency action steps, check the victim, breathing emergencies, choking, signs of heart problems, and how to perform CPR

Required for: Leaders meeting with girls, taking girls on trips, or going camping

Available to: All registered adult volunteers

Prerequisites: None

Deadlines: We must have 5 people registered 1 week before training date or training is canceled.

Supplies to Bring: Appropriate leader guide, *Safety-Wise*, and *Operational Volunteer Manual*.

Cost: Each Charter of the American Red Cross has established their own costs which is set by their trainers.

Supplies Fee: \$10.00 (includes CPR training) no book
\$25.00 (includes *Community First Aid and Safety*, Copyright 2002 book, and CPR training)
NO CONFIRMATIONS FOR REGISTRATION ARE SENT.

Book Requirement: You must have a *Community First Aid and Safety*, Copyright 2002 book with you at the time of the class. If you do not have one you can register for one and it will be provided for you. If you and your assistant leader are taking the training you may share a book.
