TERM: Each term is for one year.

### ***GENERAL DESCRIPTION***

As set forth in the GSMB council bylaws, a council delegate will provide feedback and comments regarding the overall policy direction of the council and to elect those responsible for ongoing policy decision—the corporate officers and board member.

### ***RESPONSIBILITIES***

- ◆ Maintain the integrity of the Girl Scout program through adherence to GSUSA and GSMB policies, procedures, and guidelines
- ◆ Be informed: Study the council self-training manual
  - know the council goals and objectives
  - be familiar with important documents
  - study the background materials mailed with the annual meeting announcement (30 days prior to the meeting)
- ◆ Obtain opinions from members of your Association concerning the agenda items for the annual meeting.
- ◆ Attend the annual meeting held in January each year to elect new officers and members-at-large to the council board of directors; provide input concerning the overall policy direction of the council.

### ***QUALIFICATIONS***

- ◆ GSUSA membership
- ◆ Active member of the Girl Scouts of Mitten Bay
- ◆ 14 years of age or older
- ◆ Willingness to work with diverse populations
- ◆ Be elected as a delegate by an area Association as outlined in the council by-laws.
