First Aid

Leaders will become First Aid certified by an American Red Cross trainer. Troops are required to have a First Aid and CPR trained adult at meetings, or trips, and while camping.

Training content includes: Injury dressings, shock, burns, injuries to muscles, bones, and joints, splinting, and poisoning.

Required for: Leaders meeting with girls, taking girls on trips, or going camping

Available to: All registered adult volunteers

Prerequisites: None

Deadlines: We must have 5 people registered 1 week before training date or training is canceled.

Supplies to Bring: Appropriate leader guide, *Safety-Wise*, and *Operational Volunteer Manual*.

Cost: Each Charter of the American Red Cross has established their own costs which is set by their trainers.
